Competition REGULATIONS -

**WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN BELT WRESTLING
AMONG BOYS AND GIRLS AGED 15-17 (born in 2007-2009)**

Kazan, Republic of Tatarstan, Russian Federation

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN BELT WRESTLING AMONG BOYS AND GIRLS AGED 15-17 (2007-2009)

1. Goals and objectives.

- popularization and development of belt wrestling in the world;
 - strengthening and developing international humanitarian and sports relations and cross-cultural cooperation .
- exchange between the peoples of different countries.

2. Venue and dates of the event.

Venue: 1G Fatykh Amirkhan str., Kazan, Republic of Tatarstan

Ak Bars Martial Arts Palace.

Dates: November 12-14, 2024.

3. Competition organizers.

Guidelines for organizing and conducting competitions are provided by the International Belt Wrestling Federation, the All-Russian Belt Wrestling Federation, the Ministry of Sports of the Republic of Tatarstan, and the Belt Wrestling Federation of the Republic of Tatarstan.

4. Requirements for participants and conditions of their admission.

Athletes born in 2007-2009 who have the citizenship of their country represented by the national federation (association) of belt wrestling are allowed to participate in the competition.

Official composition of delegations from national belt wrestling federations:

- boys (freestyle): 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 71, 77, 85, 95, 95+ kg.
- girls (freestyle): 44, 48, 52, 57, 63, 70, 70+ kg.
- 1 manager, 1 coach, 2 judges.

Athletes from each country are allowed to compete, with two competitors in each weight category.

Financial expenses of participants of the second composition are carried out by the sending organizations.

Each delegation must provide the organizing committee with two national flags (120 cm by 180 cm) and a CD/DVD with a recording of the national anthem (short version).

5. Competition conditions.

Competitions are held in freestyle among boys and girls, in accordance with the current international rules of judging on belt wrestling, under the control of the judging panel of the International Federation of Belt Wrestling. First, second and two third places are awarded in each weight category.

6. Financing.

Expenses related to the competition are carried out with the participation of the International Belt Wrestling Federation and the Ministry of Sports of the Republic of Tatarstan and are distributed according to additional written agreements of the parties.

7. Award ceremony.

Athletes who take 1st, 2nd and two 3rd places in their weight categories are awarded with medals, diplomas and valuable prizes from the Organizing Committee. The winning coach is awarded a diploma.

8. Ensuring the safety of participants and spectators.

The chief judge of the competition is obliged, in accordance with the Recommendations for ensuring safety and preventing injuries during Physical Culture and Sports:

- check the condition and readiness of the competition venue, inventory and equipment, premises for the secretariat, judges, make sure that there is an act on the suitability of the facility for holding sports and entertainment events, sign an Act on the readiness of the sports facility for holding this competition;
- start competitions only if there is a doctor on duty or a medical team on duty;
- allow athletes to participate in competitions only if they provide the original contract (insurance policy) on accident, life and health insurance (athletes are insured by sending organizations).

Competitions are allowed to be held in sports facilities that have been put into operation by state commissions and subject to the availability of technical inspection certificates.

Owners (users) of sports facilities are responsible for timely notification to the supervisory authorities about the conduct of competitions and compliance with their requirements (the Ministry of Internal Affairs, Rospotrebnadzor, etc.), ensure public order and public safety (a video surveillance system and technical equipment are required in accordance with the safety rules for official sports competitions to organize access and intra-object mode).

The basis for admission of an athlete to sports competitions based on medical certificates is an application with the mark "Admitted" next to each athlete's surname with the signature of a physical therapy doctor or a sports medicine doctor and certified by a personal seal, if there is a signature with a transcript of the doctor's full name at the end of the application, certified by the seal of the medical organization that has a license to perform medical care activities, a list of works and services that includes physical therapy and sports medicine (a medical certificate of admission to competitions is possible, signed by a physical therapy doctor or a sports medicine doctor and certified with the seal of a medical organization that meets the above requirements).

Medical admission of participants to sports competitions is carried out not earlier than one month before participation in sports competitions.

Personal safety, including insurance, is the sole responsibility of the competitor. Each participant must have a health insurance policy and personal protective equipment. The organizing organization and the judging panel are not responsible for any physical damage to the competitor, for his life, damage to his property or loss of property during the competition.

9. Submission of applications for participation.

A preliminary application containing information about athletes (including a judge, coach - representative) participating in international sports competitions is sent 10 days before the start of the competition to the organizing committee for the competition at the address: Kazan, Safiullina str., 8, tel.: +7(843) 261-93-22, E-mail: ibwa2018@bk.rubk.ru, asb-fsb@mail.ru

Applications certified by the doctor and the national belt wrestling Federation are submitted to the judging panel on the day of arrival.

The application must be accompanied by the following documents for each athlete:

- a copy of the athlete's passport or international passport;
- insurance contract (original).

This provision is an official challenge to the competition.
